Arguments against highlighted practical challenges and personal interest factors.


● **Games and Sports:**

Friendly matches including Dodgeball, Basketball, Kho-Kho, and 15 Pass Game.


Tug of War was the most exciting event, showcasing team effort and enthusiasm.




